UNDERGRADUATE

Título otorgado normalmente por un Community College después de completar dos años de estudios (los primeros dos años de grado).

BACHELOR'S

Título de grado universitario otorgado por un college o universidad después de completar 4 años de estudios.

- Bachelor of Arts (BA)
- Bachelor of Science (BS)

GRADUATE

Programa de titulación de postgrado (máster, doctorado o certificado de postgrado).

MASTER'S

Título de postgrado otorgado por un college o universidad. Normalmente requiere entre uno o dos años de estudios después de la obtención del grado.

- Master of Arts (MA)
- Master of Science (MS)

DOCTORAL

El título académico más alto otorgado por una universidad.

Los programas de doctorado en EE. UU. normalmente tienen una duración de 5 a 8 años.

PROFESSIONAL DEGREES

Título de orientación al ejercicio de una profesión, por ejemplo:

- Master of Business Administration (MBA)
- Master of Laws (LLM)
- Master of Public Health (MPH)
- Master of Fine Arts (MFA)





NCAA

To be successful in college, students need to be prepared for college coursework. In Division I and Division II, the NCAA sets academic initial-eligibility standards that take into account GPA, standardized test scores, core courses taken in high school and the grades earned in those core courses. Division III schools hold student-athletes to the same overall standards for the institution in which they're enrolling. All student-athletes also must meet the unique acceptance requirements of the college or university they plan to attend (which may exceed NCAA standards).
